ORDER

Defense counsel have responded to our Order of May 29, 2002 by requesting three additional redactions from Dr. Patterson's report. The requests for redactions from pages 12 and 13 are DENIED because the statements do not reflect either an attorney-client communication or an element of defense strategy. The request for a deletion from page 8 is GRANTED only for the last line and a half of the proposed redaction starting with the words "and the" because the information that follows may reveal defense strategy.

For these reasons, it is hereby

ORDERED that a copy of Dr. Patterson's report with pages 14 through the middle of page 17 and the one additional redaction from page 8 be forwarded to counsel for the government forthwith; and it is further

ORDERED that any additional psychiatric reports be filed with the Court under seal and exchanged with opposing counsel and the defendant by noon, Tuesday, June 4, 2002. Any further

memoranda regarding defendant's motion to waive counsel and proceed pro se must be filed by 3:00 p.m. Friday, June 7, 2002.

The Clerk is directed to forward copies of this Order to counsel of record and the defendant.
