ORDER

To facilitate the pro se defendant's access to discovery, it is hereby

ORDERED that the United States Marshals Service deliver to the Alexandria Adult Detention Center the computer provided by the Administrative Office of the Courts for the defendant's use in reviewing discovery materials;<sup>1</sup> and it is further

ORDERED that the Order of April 26, 2002 be and is amended to the extent that counsel for the United States may communicate and correspond directly with Mr. Moussaoui to arrange for the production of unclassified discovery materials to him. The defendant is, once again, advised that anything he communicates to the United States may be used against him in this criminal prosecution.

<sup>1</sup> The United States Marshal is also directed to provide court-supplied envelopes and paper to Captain Mitchell at the Alexandria City Adult Detention Center, who is authorized to distribute these supplies to Mr. Moussaoui as needed.

The Clerk is directed to forward copies of this Order to counsel for the United States, the defendant, pro se, stand-by counsel, the Court Security Officer, and the United States Marshal.
