ORDER

The defendant, pro se, has filed a Motion to See Bro Freeman Before My Grand Jury Testimony on 16 July (Docket #315), and a Motion to Compel the FBI to Confess Publicly that They Were Lying When They Alleged that Ramzi is Ahad Sabet (Docket #317). These motions are DENIED as moot in light of our Orders of July 11, 2002 (see Docket #s 309 and 310).

The defendant, pro se, has also filed a Motion to Have a Hearing Scheduled Today Held As Soon As Possible Next Week (Docket #318); and a Motion to Compel the FBI to Release My Letter to the European Court of Justice and Parliament, the German High Court and Parliament, the British High Court and Parliament, [sic] the Deutch High Court and Parliament (Docket #316). In these motions, the defendant reiterates requests advanced in previous motions, some of which were resolved by the Court's Order of July 11, 2002 (see Docket #309). Accordingly, these motions are DENIED as both moot and cumulative.

Finally, the defendant has filed a Motion for Pre Contempt

of Leonie M. Brinkema Order [sic] to Declare Zacarias Moussaoui Crazy (Docket #314). Because we find this motion to be frivolous, and because it does not request specific relief, it is DENIED.

The Clerk is directed to forward copies of this Order to the defendant, pro se; counsel for the United States; and standby defense counsel.
