ORDER

The defendant, pro se, has filed a Motion for Justice and Truth (Docket #367) in which he questions the accuracy of a declaration by Pasquale J. D'Amuro, Assistant Director of the Counterterrorism Division of the Federal Bureau of Investigation, stating that the FBI did not conduct electronic surveillance of Mr. Moussaoui before September 11, 2001. Because this "motion" does not request any specific relief, it is DENIED.<sup>1</sup>
