

ORDER

The defendant, pro se, has filed a Motion to Expulse [sic] the United States from the Arabian Discovery Cave (Docket #458) in which he requests an end to the two-day search of his records by the United States Marshals Service for discovery documents inadvertently produced to the defendant by the United States.¹ Although this search has caused a two-day interruption in the defendant's trial preparation, the continuance of the trial date and the granting of the defendant's motions requesting access to standby counsel's discovery web site will ensure that this interruption does not prejudice the defendant. For these reasons, the motion is DENIED; and it is hereby

ORDERED that the search may continue until 5:00 p.m. on Wednesday, August 28, 2002, after which no further intrusion will be permitted.
