ORDER

On Friday, September 20, 2002, standby defense counsel filed a Reply to the Government's Response to Court's Order on Computer and Email Evidence. Although the Reply has been publicly filed and posted on the court's web site, the United States expressed concern that the public filing of certain attachments would violate the February 5, 2002 Protective Order. As an interim remedy, all of the attachments to standby counsel's Reply were initially filed under seal. Having been advised that the parties have reached an agreement as to the proper treatment of the attachments to standby counsel's Reply, it is hereby

ORDERED that standby counsel submit to the Clerk of Court forthwith in electronic format those attachments which the parties have agreed may be unsealed; and it is further

ORDERED that the parties advise the Court forthwith as to the status of the revised protective order, which the United States was directed to draft in consultation with the defendant, pro se, and standby counsel pursuant to our orders of August 29

and September 4, 2002.

The Clerk is directed to forward copies of this Order to the defendant, pro se; counsel for the United States; and standby defense counsel.
