ORDER

Before the Court is standby counsel's Motion to Photograph Defendant's Cell and Adjoining Workroom (Docket #582), which is unopposed by the United States. Because we find standby counsel's request to be reasonable, the motion is GRANTED; and it is hereby

ORDERED that standby counsel arrange with the United States Marshals Service and officials at the Alexandria City Adult Detention Center for a convenient time to photograph and videotape Mr. Moussaoui's cell and adjoining workroom; and it is further

ORDERED that, to preserve the security and integrity of the detention facility, standby counsel may not photograph or videotape any doorways or locks, or any persons (including the defendant); and it is further

ORDERED that neither the pro se defendant nor standby counsel may retain the originals or any copies of the photographs or videotapes; instead, all originals and copies (including but

not limited to negatives and digital files) must be filed under seal with the Clerk of Court, who will release them to the defendant or standby counsel only by order of the Court.

The Clerk is directed to forward copies of this Order to the defendant, pro se; counsel for the United States; standby defense counsel; and the United States Marshal.
