

ORDER

The defendant, pro se, has filed a Motion to Force Leonie Brinkema and Her Government to Stop Holding Abu Zubaydah and Ramzi Binalshibh Testimony in My Favor (Docket #615), in which he repeats his requests for access to Zubaydah and Binalshibh, and also requests access to Ibn al Shaykh al-Libi.

For the reasons stated on the record during a closed hearing held pursuant to the Classified Information Procedures Act on October 2, 2002, we DEFERRED ruling on defense motions for access to Zubaydah and Binalshibh and directed the United States to advise the Court of the status of these issues by December 2, 2002. For the same reasons, we DENY as cumulative the defendant's pro se motion docketed as #615 as to his request for access to Zubaydah and Binalshibh, but DEFER ruling on his request for access to al-Libi; and it is hereby

ORDERED that the United States respond to the defendant's request for access to al-Libi by Tuesday, October 29, 2002.
