ORDER

Pursuant to our Order of September 27, 2002, the United States has advised the Court of its proposed redactions to the defendant's pro se pleadings docketed as #s 672, 675, 694, 835, 838, 839, 840, 841, 847, 850, 851, 852, 853, 855, 857, 858 and 865.¹ Finding that most, but not all, of the proposed redactions strike the proper balance between the public's right to access records in criminal cases and the United States' legitimate concerns about the defendant's ability to use his pleadings inappropriately to communicate with the outside world, it is hereby

ORDERED that the defendant's pro se pleadings docketed as #s 672, 675, 694, 835, 838, 839, 840, 841, 847, 850, 851, 852, 853, 855, 857, 858 and 865 be and are unsealed with the indicated
