ORDER

By an under seal letter dated May 6, 2003, the Court Security Officer has asked the Court to issue an order directing the pro se defendant to turn over to standby defense counsel any and all handwritten notes, or copies thereof, that he has taken concerning classified materials produced to him on April 25, 2003. These materials were shared with Mr. Moussaoui in compliance with the Court's Order of April 24, 2003 pursuant to an authorized limited disclosure of classified information, which does not permit the defendant to retain in his possession the materials, themselves, handwritten copies thereof, or any notes taken while reviewing such information. Accordingly, it is hereby

ORDERED that the defendant immediately turn over to his standby defense counsel any and all notes, or copies thereof, he has taken concerning the classified information disclosed to him on April 25, 2003; and it is further

ORDERED that standby counsel maintain the defendant's notes

along with the United States' April 25, 2003 disclosure in an appropriate secure storage facility; and it is further

ORDERED that the May 6, 2003 letter from the Court Security Officer be and is unsealed.

The Clerk is directed to forward copies of this Order to the defendant, pro se; counsel for the United States; standby defense counsel; and the Court Security Officer.
