ORDER

For the reasons stated on the record during a sealed telephone conference held on July 8, 2003, the Government's Motion for Rule 15 Deposition is DENIED WITHOUT PREJUDICE.¹ If the prosecution is able to arrange for the witness to remain in the United States beyond his scheduled departure date, the Court will grant a renewed motion for the deposition to take place after 2:00 p.m. on Wednesday, July 16, 2003. To allow the defense sufficient time to prepare for the deposition, it is hereby

ORDERED that the United States forthwith provide both the defendant and standby defense counsel with all Jencks and Giglio material, including but not limited to copies of any exhibits the Government intends to use during the witness' deposition and any

agreements between the United States and the witness or the relevant foreign government.

The Clerk is directed to forward copies of this Order to the defendant, pro se; counsel for the United States; standby defense counsel; and the United States Marshal.
