ORDER

In his pro se pleading docketed as #1069, Mr. Moussaoui argues that the Government's refusal to comply with the Court's Orders of January 31 and August 29, 2003 warrants the complete dismissal of this prosecution. Having reviewed the pleading, the Court finds that it must remain entirely under seal because it is replete with inflammatory rhetoric which is inappropriate for public dissemination, and further reflects an attempt by the defendant to communicate with the outside world in violation of the Special Administrative Measures governing the conditions of his confinement. Accordingly, it is hereby

ORDERED that the defendant's pro se pleading docketed as #1069 be maintained under seal in its entirety.

The Clerk is directed to forward copies of this Order to the defendant, pro se; counsel for the United States; and standby

defense counsel.
