ORDER

Having been advised by the United States through letters dated November 17, 2003 and November 10, 2003 that it does not request any redactions to the defendant's pro se pleadings docketed as #s 1101, 1103, 1104, 1105, 1107, and 1112, it is hereby

ORDERED that the defendant's pro se pleadings docketed as #s 1101, 1103, 1104, 1105, 1107, and 1112 be unsealed in their entirety by close of business November 19, 2003.

In those letters, the United States has also proposed redactions to the defendant's pro se pleadings docketed as #s 1102 and 1108. Finding that most of the proposed redactions strike the proper balance between the public's right to access records in criminal cases and the United States' legitimate concerns about the defendant's ability to use his pleadings inappropriately to communicate with the outside world, as well as accommodate the United States' national security interests, it is

hereby

ORDERED that the defendant's pro se pleadings docketed as #s 1102 and 1108 be and are unsealed with the indicated redactions by close of business November 19, 2003.

The Clerk is directed to forward copies of this Order to counsel of record.
