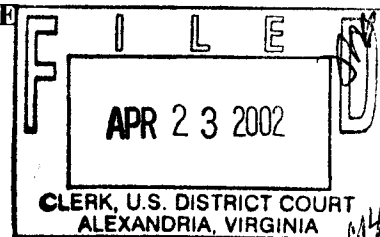

ORDER

The matter is before the Court on the Government's Motion to Permit *Ex Parte* and *In Camera* Filing of Classified Attachment to Government's Motion for Protective Order Related Primarily to Defense Discovery Request Number Four.

For good cause shown, and for the reasons stated in the April 17, 2002 Order granting the Government's Motion to Permit *Ex Parte* and *In Camera* Filing of Attachment A to the Government's Motion for Protective Order Regarding Detainee Interview Reports,¹ it is hereby **ORDERED** that the Government's Motion to Permit *Ex Parte* and *In Camera* Filing of Classified Attachment to Government's Motion for Protective Order Related Primarily to Defense Discovery Request Number Four is **GRANTED**.

Accordingly, because there is good cause to do so, it is **ORDERED** that the Classified Attachment to Government's Motion for Protective Order Related Primarily to Defense Discovery Request Number Four is hereby **FILED** *ex parte*, solely for *in camera* review in connection with the disposition of the Government's Motion for Protective Order Related Primarily to Defense Discovery Request Number Four.
