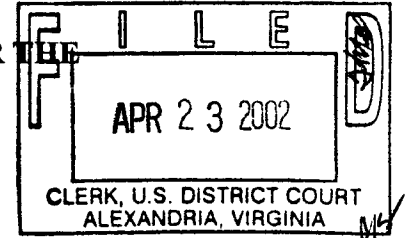

ORDER

The matter is before the Court on the Government's Motion to Permit *Ex Parte* and *In Camera* Filing of Government's *Ex Parte In Camera* Submission of Two Additional Documents.
