

ORDER

The matter came before the Court on defendant's motion for access to captured combatants detained at Guantanamo Bay, Cuba by the United States Department of Defense. In the course of the hearing defendant, by counsel, moved orally to be accorded access to the affidavit filed by the government *ex parte, in camera* on May 14, 2002. It is hereby **ORDERED** that defendant's motion is **DENIED**.

It is further **ORDERED** that defendant may renew this motion in the course of the hearings commencing June 17, 2002.
