

**PROTECTIVE ORDER REGARDING TRUE NAMES OF
ACTIVE MILITARY PERSONNEL**

WHEREAS several individuals currently serving on active duty in the United States military in Operation Enduring Freedom have agreed voluntarily to be interviewed by defense counsel in the above-captioned case;

For good cause, and upon the application of the parties, it is hereby **ORDERED** that the true names of active military personnel serving in Operation Enduring Freedom shall not, without further order of the Court, be disseminated by the defendant or his counsel to any individuals, organizations or other entities, except that defense counsel may share such information with (i) members of the defense team (i.e., co-counsel, paralegals, translators and secretarial staff), (ii) investigators or experts retained to assist in the preparation of the defense and (iii) potential witnesses who are not detainees of the United States military. Any such investigators, experts, or potential witnesses who are not currently active military personnel serving in Operation Enduring Freedom, must understand and sign a memorandum of understanding regarding the nondisclosure of the

true names of active military personnel serving in Operating Enduring Freedom, in the form attached hereto and incorporated herein as Exhibit 1. Within a reasonable time after such memorandum of understanding is signed, defense counsel shall file it with the Court, *ex parte* and under seal.

It is further **ORDERED** that any papers to be served upon the Court by either party which include or refer to the true names of any active duty military personnel serving in Operation Enduring Freedom shall be filed and placed under seal.

It is further **ORDERED** that nothing in this Order shall substitute for or abrogate any protective order already issued by this Court in the above-captioned matter.


The Clerk is directed to send a copy of this Protective Order to all counsel of record.
