

ORDER

The matter came before the Court on defendant's following motions:

- (i) Motion to Dismiss Counts Six, Seven, Eight, and Nine of the Indictment as Lacking Statutory Authority;
- (ii) Motion to Dismiss Count One of the Indictment for Failure to State a Violation of the Charging Statute;
- (iii) Motion to Dismiss Counts Two through Nine on Freedom of Association, Overbreadth, and Vagueness Grounds;
- (iv) Motion to Dismiss Count Ten of the Indictment;
- (v) Motion to Dismiss Counts Eight and Nine of the Indictment for Selective Prosecution;
- (vi) Motion to Dismiss, or the Alternative, for Transfer of Venue;
- (vii) Motion to Dismiss Counts Two, Three, Four, and Five for Failure to State a Claim Under the Charging Statute.

For the reasons stated from the bench and to be addressed in a forthcoming memorandum opinion,

It is hereby **ORDERED** that these seven motions are **DENIED**.
