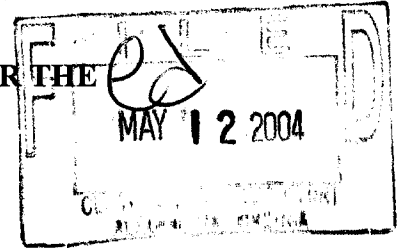

ORDER

By Order dated December 9, 2003, the parties were directed to file a pleading, either jointly or separately, setting forth those portions of the sealed record that may now be unsealed. *See United States v.
